BAC RESOLUTION NO. 2019-11-001

**RECOMMENDING THE APPROVAL OF PROCUREMENT OF SERVICE MOTOR VEHICLE
OF TESDA MIMAROPA REGIONAL OFFICE THROUGH COMPETITIVE BIDDING**

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act (GPRA)", took effect on 26 January 2003, while its 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) took effect on 28 October 2016;

WHEREAS, Section 63 of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR authorizes the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) to formulate public procurement policies, rules and regulations, and amend, whenever necessary, its IRR;

WHEREAS, Section 53(e) of RA No. 9184 allows the purchase of Goods from another agency of the Government, such as the Procurement Service (PS), which is tasked with the centralized procurement of commonly used Goods for the government in accordance with Letter of Instructions (LOI) No. 755, series of 1978 and Executive Order No. 359, series of 1989;

WHEREAS, Section 6 of Administrative Order (AO) No. 17, series of 2011 provides that the PS shall strengthen its operations and regularly conduct a survey to determine other products commonly purchased by procuring entities for inclusion to the list of Common-Use Supplies and Equipment (CSE);

WHEREAS, Section 9 of Administrative Order No. 233 series of 2018 which states that all government agencies enumerated under Section 1.0 of the same order shall seek approval from the Office of President the following types of vehicle regardless of funding sources;

- 9.1 Car (sedan or hatchback) with engine displacement not exceeding 2,200cc for gasoline or; 3,000cc if diesel fed;
- 9.2 Passenger Van or Pick-up Type Vehicle with an engine displacement not exceeding 2,200cc gasoline fed or 3,000cc diesel fed;
- 9.3 CUV/MPV/AUV with an engine displacement 2,200cc if gasoline fed and 2,500cc if diesel fed;
- 9.4 SUV with an engine displacement not exceeding 2,700cc if gasoline fed or 3,000cc if diesel fed;
- 9.5 All types of aircrafts; and
- 9.6 All types of sea-crafts, not otherwise classified under sub-section 7.4 hereof.

WHEREAS, paragraph 12 of GPPB Resolution 21-2018 provides the Department of Budget and Management has recommended the issuance of administrative order adopting a policy of centralized procurement of motor vehicle to ensure economy and efficiency, and maintain cost effective, fuel efficient and environment friendly standards or specifications and be at par, with the improvements and developments in the automotive industry and relevant technology;

WHEREAS, on 18 October 2018, the GPPB issued Resolution No. 21-2018 approving the inclusion in the list of CSEs: Motor vehicles to be used for: (i) the exercise of executive functions; (ii) transport of personnel, equipment, supplies, products and materials; (iii) transport of sick and/or injured persons; (iv) patrol operations; (v) fire-fighting operations; and (vi) Other vehicles to be identified by the Secretary of Budget and Management, except motor vehicles used exclusively for the internal and external safety or defense of the State, and requiring highly-specialized and customized specifications;

WHEREAS, Section 9 of AO No.14, series of 2018 mandates the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and the GPPB to issue rules and regulations on the specific guidelines on the approval of requests for acquisition of motor vehicles, and the typology, classification and specifications of motor vehicles and on the centralized procurement of motor vehicles, respectively;

WHEREAS. On 4 March 2019, the DBM issued Budget Circular No. 2019-2 which provides the specific guidelines on allowable engine displacements of motor vehicles that may be purchased by government agencies and the approving authorities for the acquisition of motor vehicles;

WHEREAS, on 22 April 2019, the GPPB issued Resolution No. 08-2019 authorizing the DBM and the PS to issue specific procedural process for the operationalization of a centralized procurement of motor vehicles;

WHEREAS, on 16 May 2019, the DBM issued Budget Circular No. 2019-3 which provides the guidelines on implementing the centralized procurement of motor vehicles pursuant to AO No. 14, series of 2017;

WHEREAS, GPPB Resolution No. 20-2019, dated 5 September 2019 provides that after careful review and deliberation, resolved to approve the following:

1. Delist the motor vehicles used for: (i) the exercise of executive functions; (ii) transport of personnel, equipment, supplies, products and materials; (iii) transport of sick and/or injured persons; (iv) patrol operations; and (v) fire-fighting operations from the list of common-use supplies and equipment of the Procurement Service; and
2. Inform the Office of the President, through the Executive Secretary, of the said action of the GPPB pursuant to Section 6 of AO No. 17, series of 2011 which mandates the GPPB to conduct periodic evaluation of the effectiveness of the performance of the centralized procurement system in terms of economy and efficiency;

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WHEREAS, TESDA MIMAROPA received a Special Allotment Release Order (SARO) No. ROIVB-18-0002153 dated February 19, 2018 amounting to P73,900,000, and SARO No. SARO-ROIVB-18-0006311 dated March 21, 2018 amounting to P1,100,000 for capital outlays totaling to P75,000,000 with funding source from FY 2018 General Appropriations Act RA 10964, Specific Budgets of National Government Agencies broken down as follows:

WHEREAS, letter dated January 7, 2019 from Office of the President has approved the purchase of vehicle that shall comply with the following details: (i) one (1) sports utility vehicle with an engine displacement not exceeding 2000cc for gasoline or 2400cc for diesel not to exceed P1,500,000.00;

WHEREAS, Section 10 of RA 9184 provides for all procurement shall be done through Competitive Bidding, except as provided for in Rule XVI of this IRR;

WHEREAS, Section 11 Article of RA 9184 states that each procuring entity shall established a single BAC. The BAC shall have at least five (5) members but not more than seven (7) members. It shall be chaired by at least third ranking permanent official of the procuring entity other than its head, and its composition shall be specified in the IRR.

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WHEREAS, pursuant to the preceding paragraph, the procuring entity has created the Regional Bids and Awards Committee (RBAC) to conduct the procurement of service motor vehicle of TESDA MIMAROPA Regional Office;

WHEREAS, the Regional BAC, TWG/Secretariat conducted Special Meeting on November 11, 2019 to discuss the procurement process of the Service Vehicle in accordance in the authority granted by the OP;




